TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE Chase Road Burntwood

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Staffordshire County Council being the highway authority responsible for the repair and maintenance of Chase Road in Burntwood are satisfied that it is necessary to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Chase Road from its roundabout with A5190 Cannock Road to its junction with Springhill Road for a period of 1 day but no more than 5 days from 19th February 2024 because of the likelihood of danger to the public during highway / carriageway repairs being undertaken by Staffordshire County Council / Amey Highways.

Access will be available for pedestrians and for vehicles being used in connection with the works and for emergency services vehicles and for vehicles requiring access to properties on the length of road which is closed.

An alternative route for traffic is available and will be signed on site.
